**The Arkansas National Archery in the Schools Program (ArkNASP) is the official Arkansas affiliate of the National Archery in the Schools Program (NASP) and operates using its national guidance. Archery is an activity in which people of all walks of life and almost every size and ability can participate. The ArkNASP is focused on providing a fun, safe environment for participating in archery in the school setting while raising awareness of conservation related sports, responsibility, and self-esteem.**

**The Arkansas Scholastic Archery Program will help promote archery in our schools and give students an opportunity to try something they may not have done before. This will enhance bow hunting through physical education curriculum and promote good safety habits by our students.**

**The Mountainburg School Board approved this program in its November meeting. The Arkansas Scholastic Archery Program is funded by a grant from the Arkansas Game and Fish Department. Mountainburg Schools also received a \$1,500 donation from the Crawford County Chapter of the National Wild Turkey Federation to be used for the Archery Program. The Mountainburg Schools appreciates this generous donation and will follow the guidelines for its use.**

**We will include pictures and updates of the archery program on the website as the program progresses. We will also send the information home to our parents in a quarterly newsletter.**

**The Mountainburg Schools physical education classes will use the grant-funded equipment as part of their physical education curriculum for a two week period beginning with the Spring Semester of the 2008-2009 school year. The archery program will be taught for a minimum of five years at Mountainburg Schools. The classes will be taught by Mountainburg certified and classified personnel who received training in January, 2009 from Curtis Gray of the Arkansas Game and Fish Department.**
